GENERAL DISCIPLINE

1. Every student shall strive to keep the campus clean and eco-friendly.
2. Students shall maintain silence and academic decorum in the classroom, canteen, playground, seminars, guest lectures and other gatherings.
3. Use of cell phone is strictly restricted in the college campus.
4. No private vehicle is allowed inside the campus during the working hours.
5. Students are strictly instructed not to indulge in any sort of malpractice in the internal test and University examinations.
6. Students should put on their identity card while they are in the campus and in the bus.
7. Students are expected to be regular and punctual to the class.
8. Students should wear the prescribed uniform for practical classes.

RAGGING

Ragging of any sort is strictly prohibited. The following actions will be taken against students for indulging and abetting ragging in technical institutions, as framed by All India Council for Technical Education New Delhi.

1. The Punishment to be meted out to the persons indulged in ragging to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents.
2. Every single incident of ragging a First Information Report (FIR) must be filled without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities.
3. The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, with regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging.
4. (a) Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following :-

- (i) Cancellation of admission
 - (ii) Suspension from attending classes
 - (iii) Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
 - (iv) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
 - (v) Withholding results
 - (vi) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - (vii) Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
 - (viii) Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
 - (ix) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution,
 - (x) Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggars.
- b) An appeal against the order of punishment by the Anti- Ragging Committee shall lie,
- i. In case of an order of an institution, affiliated to or constituent part, of the University, to the Vice- Chancellor of the University;
 - ii. In case of an order of a University, to its Chancellor,
 - iii. In case of an institution of national importance created by an Act of Parliament, to the Chairman or Chancellor of the institution, as the case may be.
5. The institutional authorities shall intimate the incidents of ragging occurred in their premises along with actions taken to the Council from time to time.

New Delhi, the 22nd February, 2017

Sub: Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in technical Institutions, Universities including Deemed to be Universities imparting technical education.

F. No. 34-AICTE/AR/Antiragging/2016.—In exercise of its powers conferred under sub-section (1) of Section 23 read with Section 10 and Section 11 of the All India Council for Technical Education Act, 1987 (52 of 1987) the AICTE hereby makes 2nd Amendment in Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in technical Institutions, Universities including Deemed to be Universities imparting technical education Regulations 2009 which had been notified in the Gazette of India vide File No. 37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated 01.07.2009 as under

"Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions, Universities including Deemed to be Universities imparting technical education Regulations 2009, in para 4, the following would be included/added after 4 (i) under heading "What constitutes Ragging":

4f). *Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or ethnic background "*

2. Every student is expected to have a minimum of 75% attendance in each and every theory subject and a minimum of 75% attendance in the practical classes.
3. Planned leave should be intimated to the H.O.D. in advance.
4. Absence due to unprecedented cause should be intimated to the H.O.D. before 10.00 a.m.
5. The student has to produce the Medical Certificate in case of absence due to sickness for more than 3 days.
6. Students who fail to satisfy the norms of the University will not be allowed to write the University Examinations.
7. Leave will not be granted on the re-opening day / closing day of a term and on examination days except for valid reasons.

LIBRARY

Library at T.J.S. Engineering college provides uncompromising information and intellectual requirements to its students and faculty with a user-friendly approach. It offers a fully integrated and dynamic environment for conducting academic study. The library contains rich collection of 16600 books, Magazines, 40 National, 30 Inter-National journals on general and various disciplines. NPTEL facility (National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning) to access video lectures, DELNET for resource sharing and Digital library with 10 systems to access the E-Journals, E-Books, CD/DVDs are available in library.

RULES

1. The library will be kept open between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on working days.
2. Books will be lent to the users only against producing their ID cards.
3. Staff and students can borrow a maximum of 4 books respectively.
4. The books lent can be retained by the students for 14 days and by the staff for 21 days, from the date of issue.
5. Reference books will not be issued.
6. Only one time renewal of book will be permitted and that too, if there is no reservation against that particular book.
7. Books borrowed should be returned on the due date between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. If not, fine of Re. 1 per day, shall be levied.
8. Books due on holidays may be returned on the next working day.
9. The borrower shall examine the pages of the book for any damage before leaving the library and report the same to the Librarian immediately. If the book is found to be damaged while returning, the borrower will be held responsible for the same.
10. The book lost should be replaced with a new copy. If the book is not available, double the cost of the book will be collected.
11. Every visit of the student to the library should be entered in the Library Entry Register.
12. Marking on books, soiling, underlining, writing remarks on pages, folding or tearing of pages etc., will be held as serious charges.
13. Requirement of new books shall be intimated to the Librarian through the HOD concerned.

MENTOR SYSTEM

This unique feature aims to ensure a healthy relationship between the staff and the students. Each staff member is assigned 15 students under this system. The staff counsels the students in moral, academic and personal spheres so as to help them become professionals with ethics and values.



Study Hours:	5.00 a.m. to 7.00 a.m. 8.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m.
Supper:	7.00 p.m. to 8.00 p.m.

DISCIPLINE

- Discipline in the hostel will be under the control of the Warden and Deputy Warden.
- Residents and their guests are forbidden to enter the kitchen.
- Students should not remain in the hostel during the class hours and at other times when their presence is expected in the Institution except with the permission of the warden / Deputy Warden for genuine reasons.
- Students whose names are removed from the roll call of the Institution shall forfeit hostel accommodation and must vacate the room forthwith; Staying in hostels without authorization is a strictly prohibited action.
- Residents and day scholars should not come to the rooms during free hours when the Institute is in session.
- Whenever inmates are leaving the hostel, they must enter their names, time of leaving and the purpose in the "OUT" register available at the gate and on their return, they must enter the time of their arrival in it.
- No student of first year should be found in senior student's room or vice versa, for any reason.
- No phone calls (incoming/outgoing) will normally be encouraged during study hours. Any calls of an emergency/inevitable nature need to be justified to the authorities.
- Anyone found guilty of ragging or preventing others from attending classes is liable to be expelled from the hostel and institute immediately.

- No student can leave the hostel for any reason without the written permission of Warden/Deputy warden. In addition, if the students including day scholars, who want to go out during regular class/lab hours, tea/lunch interval, they should also enter the details and sign in the register at the Institute's main gate. In case, prior permission has to be obtained to leave the campus, the fact should be indicated in the register.

HOSTEL FEES

- Before admission, each student has to pay admission fee, mess deposit, establishment and other charges which may be revised from time to time

CLEANLINESS IN THE HOSTEL

- Residents are responsible for the cleanliness of the rooms, corridors etc. They should see that rooms are properly swept every day by servants for that purpose.

All waste paper and refuse must be placed in the specially provided place for this purpose.

Students are not permitted to take their meals to their rooms.

As a special case, when a student is confined to bed due to illness, the food may be served in his/her room with the permission of the Warden/Deputy Warden.

Use of Radio, TV, extra lamp and other electrical appliances such as electric iron, electric stove or immersion heater is not permitted. If any of these items are found in the rooms, the same will be confiscated.

Decayable and Non-Decayable items should be put in separate.

FURNITURE AND HOSTEL PROPERTY

- Hostellers will be held responsible for all damages to furniture, fittings etc. in their respective rooms.
- Each room is provided with Table, Chairs, wall clock, night lamp, Bookshelves, Dustbins and bedding.
- The rooms should be kept neat and tidy. No papers and posters should be pasted on the walls.
- The hostel is meant to be a home away from home for students. The inmates of the hostel are expected to be mutually friendly and co-operative with their fellow students.
- Discipline of highest order is to be maintained everywhere.
- Day scholars are not permitted to enter the hostel without prior permission from the Warden.
- Smoking or use of liquor or any other intoxicants or playing cards is strictly prohibited.
- The guilty will be expelled from the hostel with immediate effect.
- Students should devote these hours only to their studies.
- Attendance will be taken every night and kept for record.
- Prior permission should be obtained from their hostel authorities for the entry of visitors/guests in the hostel.
- They are expected to maintain order and discipline.
- Students will be charged for the breakages such as Tube light fittings, fans, stools, window glasses etc.
- Visiting hours on working days are between 5.00 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. and on holidays between 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.
- The visitors for girl students should produce visitors ID card, and only then they will be allowed to see their wards.

- Students are not allowed to go home every week end.
- They are allowed to go home only once in a month after submitting the requisition letter from their parents in written forms; phone calls or telegrams shall not be entertained in this regard.
- Violating the hostel rules will invite the severe punishment to the extent of being expelled from the hostel without any intimation to the parents.
- A separate declaration form containing the rules and regulations of the hostel will be issued to the students at the time of joining the hostel every year.
- This must be signed by the students and their parents
- Ragging in any form is illegal and strictly prohibited. Severe action with punishment including imprisonment will be taken against those who indulge in such activities.
- Students must strictly adhere to the timings of the mess.
- If a student is ill, the same should be reported to the warden, who will then make suitable arrangements to take care of that particular student.
- Electrical switches must be put off, whenever not required / while going out of room. Water taps should be closed after use.
- Students are advised not to keep their valuables / cash in the hostel / room.
- Each student should see that the room occupied by him/her is kept neat and clean. A complaint register is available with the warden for reporting on hygiene and repairs.
